SCHOOL RULES

The purpose of rules is to ensure the safety and well-being of all members of the community. Courtesy and consideration for others are expected at all times and pupils are expected to embrace the core values of the school - trust, respect, honesty, compassion and tolerance.

Behaviour: Please refer to the Rewards and Sanctions and Behaviour Management policy **School property** and the property of others must be treated with respect.

Movement about the School: Walk quietly and sensibly at all times to ensure safety of all, and lack of disruption to others who may be in lessons.

Care of the School Environment: Pupils must not consume food and drink outside the approved areas. Bags must not be left in the corridor and pupils should ensure that they are stored in designated areas. Do all that you can to ensure that all parts of the School are kept tidy taking responsibility for your own belongings and litter.

Signing Out: No pupil may leave the school grounds without permission or without signing out.

Uniform must be worn as set out in the School uniform policy.

Classroom Etiquette: Arrive on time and properly equipped for lessons. This includes wearing the correct uniform for each lesson.

Forbidden Items: Alcohol, tobacco, non-prescribed drugs, chewing gum, iPods, MP3 Players, recording devices, items of jewellery not on the uniform list and any other dangerous or valuable items.

ALWAYS show respect and courtesy for your classmates, teachers, visitors and all you come across in your school day.

Prescribed medicines must be handed in to the School Office.

Mobile phones MUST be turned off when you arrive at School and kept in your locker until you go home.

Personal Data: The School will deal with any personal data relating to pupils in accordance with the Data Protection Policy. Pupils should not give out personal data about fellow pupils or staff e.g. addresses, phone numbers, e-mail addresses without the consent of the individual involved.

Bullying is not tolerated. The School has an anti-bullying policy in operation, a copy of which is available on the website for all pupils and staff. Any incident of bullying will be treated very seriously

Travelling to School: Realise that on your journey to and from School and on School trips you are still representing our School. Your behaviour must uphold our good reputation.
